

# Information about Buying Prints



I can print on paper or canvas at any size shown overleaf (*other sizes available on request*).  
I always make sure that pictures will remain sharp when printed at larger sizes (20 inches /50cm wide or more).

I use archival Epson K3 inks and the latest colour calibration equipment when printing to ensure that colours are transferred faithfully onto paper or canvas. I also use museum quality paper for longevity, produced by prestigious manufacturers such as Hahnemuhle, Canson and Innova.

All paper prints are sold with a backing board and in an Ultimat professional-quality mount to prevent fading or staining over time.

Mounted prints can also be sold in a quality solid wood frame of light oak or black.

Prints are a limited edition of 50 only.
